#### INTRODUCTION

This Annual Water and Sewer Retail Rate Survey is prepared annually by the MWRA Advisory Board, and is designed to provide a comparative snapshot of water and sewer retail rates for each community in the MWRA service area. This year the survey has been expanded to include a sample of other Massachusetts communities which are not in the MWRA service area, and a sample of other cities nation wide.

The survey was compiled primarily via a questionnaire sent to participating communities. In addition to the sixty communities in the MWRA service area, thirty-eight Massachusetts communities outside of the MWRA service area were also surveyed, of which twenty-one responded and from which nineteen submitted sufficient information to be included in this survey. Questionnaires were also sent to cities outside of Massachusetts, the selection of which is based upon the collection of cities included in the Water & Wastewater Study conducted bi-annually by the firm of Ernst & Young.

We are grateful to both the local water and wastewater managers and their local representative who agreed to participate in the survey.




## MWRA COMMUNITIES' 1993 WATER AND SEWER COSTS


# COMPARATIVE RESIDENTIAL 1993 WATER AND SEWER COSTS FOR U.S. CITIES
