#### INTRODUCTION

This is the tenth "Annual Water and Sewer Retail Rate Survey" prepared by the Massachusetts Water Resources Authority (MWRA) Advisory Board, providing a comparative snapshot of water and sewer retail rates for each community in the MWRA service area. In addition, this is the fourth year in which the survey also incorporates rate information for other Massachusetts communities not in the MWRA service area, as well as other cities nationwide.

This year's survey is the second to reflect the impacts of the new MWRA sewer rate methodology.

The Advisory Board was instrumental in developing the new methodology which allocates operating costs based on total metered flow and allocates capital costs based upon a combination of maximum monthly flow, contributing population, and census population. Implementation of the new methodology took place on July 1, 1995 with first year impacts on communities mitigated by a floor and ceiling for rate changes.

For the past several years the Rate Survey has been the Advisory Board's most requested document. We hope that municipal officials, water and sewer industry professionals and concerned citizens continue to find the information presented in the survey useful and informative. As always, we welcome any questions or suggestions regarding this survey which will allow us to provide a stronger document in future years. #### The MWRA Advisory Board

The MWRA Advisory Board was created by the Massachusetts Legislature in 1984 to represent the interests of Massachusetts Water Resources Authority service area communities. The Advisory Board is comprised of one representative from each of the sixty communities that receive water and/or sewer services from the MWRA, and one from the Metropolitan Area Planning Council. In addition six people are appointed by the Governor to include a person with skills and expertise in matters relating to environmental protection, one representative each from the Connecticut River basin, the Quabbin/Ware watershed areas, and the Wachusett watershed area, plus two persons qualified by membership or affiliation in organizations concerned with the recreational or commercial uses of the Boston Harbor.

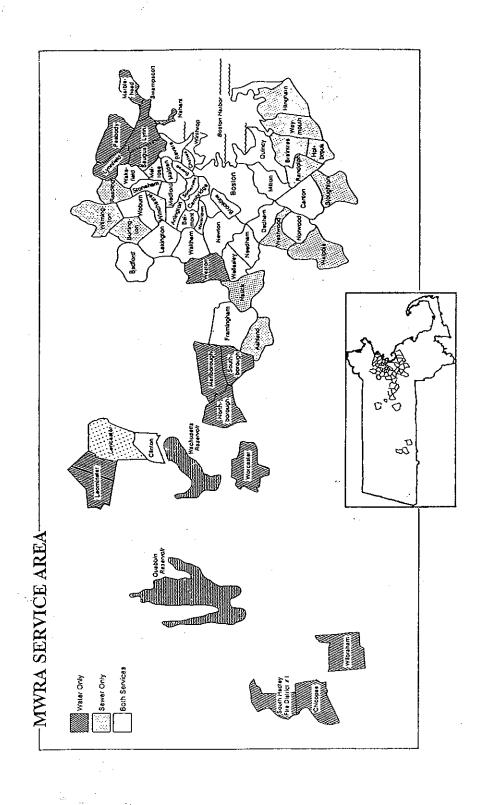
The Advisory Board actively monitors the MWRA's programs from the perspective of ratepayers, and has been delegated specific responsibilities by the Massachusetts Legislature. These include:

- serving as a watchdog over the MWRA to insure proper management and budgetary control at the MWRA;
- making recommendations to the MWRA on annual expense budgets, capital facility programs, business planning, and user charges;
- holding hearings on matters relating to the MWRA and making recommendations to the Governor and the Legislature regarding the MWRA; and,
- appointing three members to the eleven member MWRA Board of Directors.

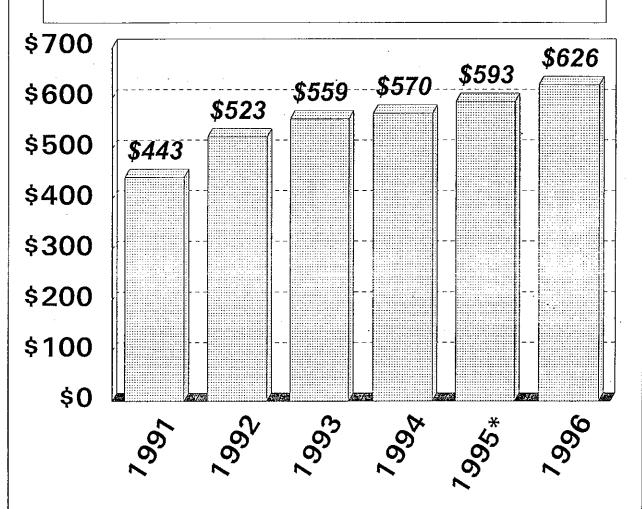
Advisory Board programmatic and budget recommendations have led to significant savings for MWRA ratepayers. The Advisory Board has outlined a multi-faceted approach to managing rates which includes reductions in proposed capital outlays, tighter current expense budgeting controls, and attainment of state and federal assistance. The Advisory Board's efforts resulted in a 1.3% rate increase for FY96, and a less than 5% increase for FY97. Special assignments, including the development of the MWRA sewer rate methodology, a cost-benefit analysis of MWRA covered storage projects, and the Advisory Board's current efforts to develop a system expansion policy, emphasize the ongoing constructive relationship between the Advisory Board and the Authority to establish the most cost-effective and efficient water and wastewater systems possible.

# CHARGES 1996 MWRA COMMUNITY NATER AND SEWER C



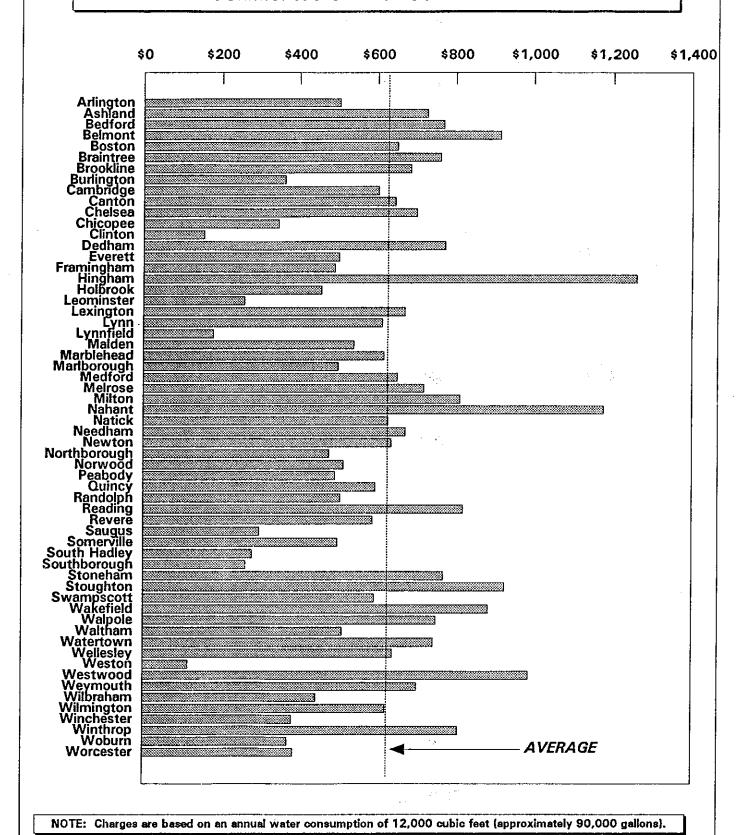
# Combined Annual Water & Sewer Charges in MWRA Communities 1991 - 1996
